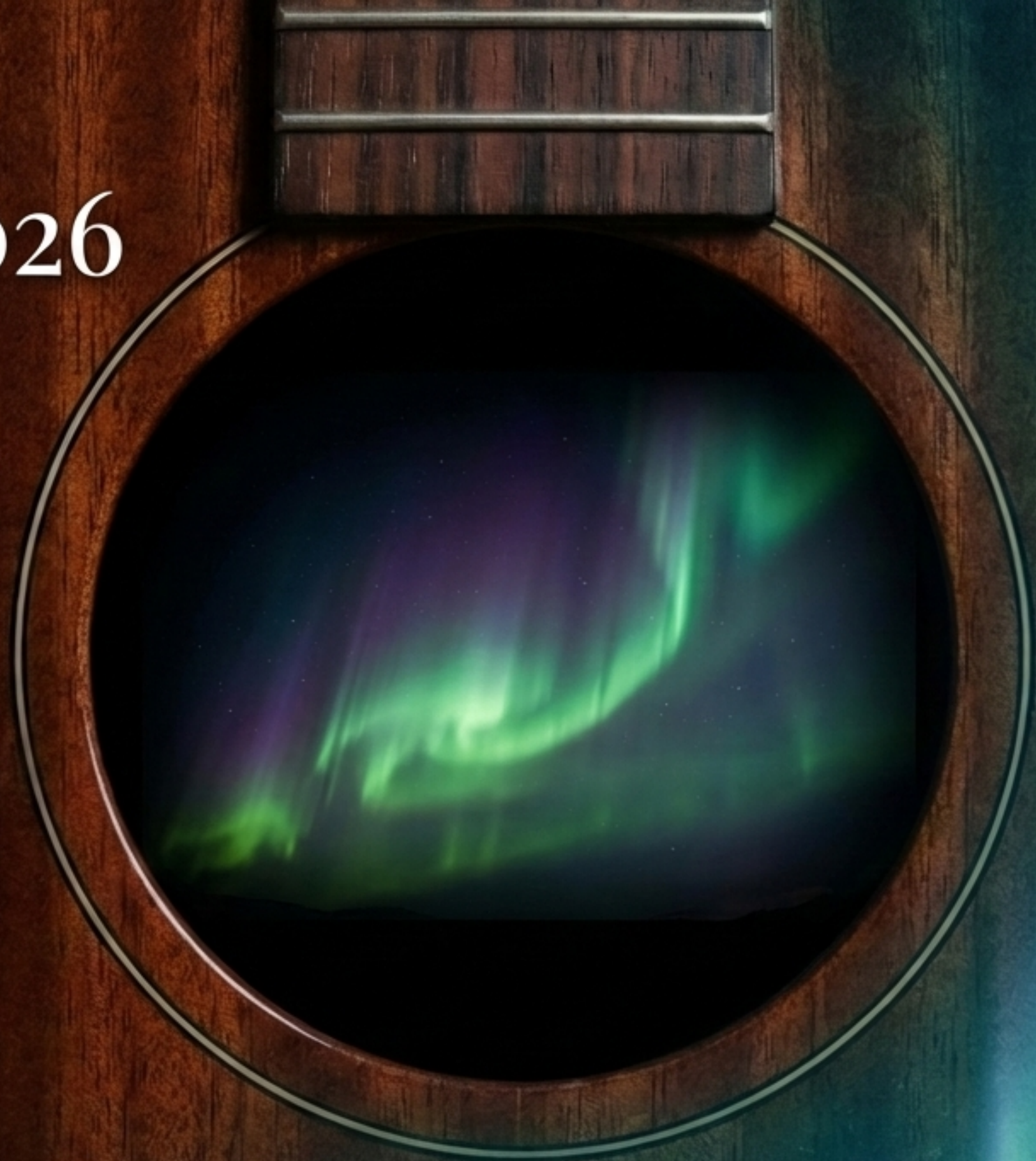
Corporate Giving Eligible
